1. a.
$$S_{\text{max}} = 380 \text{ nW/m}^2$$

b.
$$P_{RX} = 16 \text{ nW}$$

Intermediate result: For both antennas, G = 1,512.

Remember that you must show how this value was obtained.

2.
$$P_{RX} = 7.9 \text{ pW to } 1.8 \text{ nW}$$

3.
$$P_{t,\text{min}} = 0.86 \text{ mW}.$$

Some intermediate calculation results: For the RX antenna, $R_{loss} = 7.68 \text{ m}\Omega$ and $G_{RX} = 0.37$. Remember that you must show how these values were obtained.
