Goal:

- convey ideas and concepts
- \longrightarrow be clear
- \longrightarrow get your audience interested

Preparation:

- know subject (main project: model & background)
- slides (see more below)
- demo (only if possible)
- write a script for what you will say
- practice (aloud, alone & for friend, time yourself)

Talks

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Oral Presentation:

- volume
- right pace
- conversational style (do not just read, but use scientific jargon → difficult → practice)
- vary intonation, stresses and pacing

Non-Verbal (Body):

- use pointer
- eye contact
- facial expressions, gestures
- posture, breathing

Talks

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 \longrightarrow get your audience interested

Slides:

- tool of your choice (e.g. google slides, power point, Latex)
- main point?
- audience?
- large enough font
- use colors meaningful (e.g. no distracting background)
- content for
 - mini-project I: variation of your choice (more info later)
 - main project talks: outline, intro & background, model, (simulation methods), summary
- repeat main points
- clear transitions (coherent thread)
