Writing Assignment 14A:

- 2. the structure and the flow of your argument.

3. the opening sentence and the first paragraph. (Does it set the scene? Does it focus the reader on the specific aspects of your thesis?)

Writing Assignment 14B:

Prepare a 100—150 word report on the aspects of your draft that you attempted to address in the latest revision. End by mentioning your plans for the next phase of revisions.

Also, report the following information:

- amount of time spent making revisions to current draft;
- number of distinct sessions spent on the current draft;
- number of sentences modified; number of paragraphs modified;
- number of sentences deleted;
- number of sentences added.
